

2017 Summer Ag Institute Funding Guidelines Illinois Agriculture in the Classroom

In an effort to continue to expand funding for the Summer Ag Institutes (SAI), the following guidelines will be in place for the 2017 Summer Season as granted by Illinois Agriculture in the Classroom (IAITC). Remember, per your request there will not be a brochure. Instead, an online brochure will be **posted on our website**.

- \$300 Each institute will be given a **Flat Grant of \$300**. Additional funding opportunities will be earned through the following factors:
- \$300 By informing IAITC of the dates of your 2017 SAI by **Friday, January 13, 2017**, so the dates can be published in the IAITC Web SAI Brochure, each SAI will be allowed an additional \$300. Scheduling concerns and comments should be addressed to Carol Harms-Garman. No additional funds will be granted for dates scheduled after **January 13, 2017**.
- \$300 By scheduling the IAITC Presentation by no later than **Friday, March 31, 2017**, the SAI will be granted \$300. Scheduling concerns and comments should be addressed to Carol Harms-Garman.
- \$200 By allowing the IAITC staff to present a **3 hour** presentation at the SAI, each SAI will be granted \$200. A **2 hour** presentation will be granted \$100. Presentations of less than 2 hours are not eligible for this portion of the grant.
- \$200 By submitting the completed Pre and Post SAI Teacher Survey **online** by **Friday, August 4, 2017**, each SAI will be granted \$200. Submitting only one (Pre or Post) of the completed online Teacher Surveys by the deadline will earn \$100.
- \$200 By sharing sample lesson plans generated by class participants by **August 4, 2017**, the SAI will earn \$200.
- \$500 Commodity presenters contacted and **used** for SAI presentation.
- \$2,000** **Total Grant Available for EACH Summer Ag Institute**
