AG EDUCATION	the teaching of students to prepare them for successful careers in agriculture, food, fiber, and natural resources systems
AGRICULTURE	the science of cultivating soil, producing crops, and raising livestock
AGRICULTURAL BUSINESS	career field that combines the world of agriculture with the fundamentals of business
AGRICULTURE MECHANICS	the selection, operation, maintenance, service, selling, design, repair, construction, and use of machinery and equipment for agricultural purposes
ANIMAL SCIENCE	the science of domesticating animals of both the livestock and companion varieties
CAREER	a job or profession that someone does for a long period of time
ECONOMY	a system of making and trading things of value
ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES	an industry which serves to produce goods, services, or research in efforts to measure, prevent, limit, or correct environmental damages
FOOD SCIENCE	the study of food, food processing, and the improvement of foods
NATURAL RESOURCES	the study and management of natural resources, such as land, water, soil, plants, and animals
OCCUPATION	the work that a person does, especially as a way of earning a living
PLANT SCIENCE	also known as botany; a branch of biology that deals with the study of plants
PROFESSIONAL	anyone who earns their living from performing an activity that requires a certain level of education, skill, or training
