BEEF	the meat the comes from beef cattle. Hamburger, steak, and brisket are some examples of beef
BOVINE	the scientific name for cattle
DIGESTION	the process of breaking down food in the body
BY-PRODUCTS	all products, except for beef, that come from beef cattle
RUMINANT	animals, such as cattle, that have multiple compartments in their stomach that serve specific purposes in breaking down food
SILAGE	fermented corn, wheat, or hay with the stalks and leaves that is chopped and fed to cattle
BULL	a male cow used for breeding
cow	a female cow that has given birth to a calf
HEIFER	a female cow that has not yet given birth to a calf
STEER	a male cow not used for breeding
CALF	cattle less than a year old
HEAD	one beef animal
