SOYBEAN VOCABULARY



| SEED COAT | outside cover that protects the seed |
|--------------------|---|
| HILUM | brown spot; allows water into the seed coat |
| COTYLEDON | the first food source for the soybean and will become the first pair of leaves |
| LEGUME | a type of plant that "fixes" - or puts in - Nitrogen in the soil |
| EMBRYO | part of the seed that develops into a new plant, including the stems, leaves, and roots |
| TAP ROOT | the main root of the plant, which smaller roots branch out of |
| LATERAL ROOTS | roots that extend from the tap root and absorb water and nutrients from the soil |
| BIODIESEL | a renewable fuel made from biological sources like soybeans |
| COMMODITY | a raw material or primary agricultural product that can be bought and sold |
| RENEWABLE RESOURCE | a resource that is replenished naturally over time |
| BIOPLASTIC | a plastic made from biological materials like plants. Bioplastics are fully decompostable |
